100 YEARS AGO

Local: The wedding between Mr William Drake of Tedburn and Miss Florence Dyer, daughter of Mr F. Dyer was solemnised in Trusham church.

National: George V made public his desire that at the anniversary of the Armistice, for two minutes activities - work, sound, locomotion should cease, so that in stillness thoughts may be concentrated on reverent remembrance of the glorious dead.

International: Health officials declared the deadly Spanish flu pandemic was over. It had killed a tenth of the estimated 500 million infected

200 YEARS AGO Rev Burrington, Chudleigh's vicar, sent John Jenkin to a House of Correction for showing a picture and describing a slaughter by cavalry (Peterloo Massacre August 1819). On November 30th, he wrote to the government, his deposition signed by over 140 of 'Nobility, Gentry, Clergy, Freeholders and Chudleigh Residents' impressed with dangers from the dissemination of blasphemous, seditious publications, some distributed in this county, deeming it expedient to express determination to prevent the propagation of blasphemous and seditious publications; to inculcate, respect for our excellent constitution, and subordination to the law, of which the Christian Religion forms a most important part
