100 YEARS AGO

Local: Trusham's new rector, William Durham, married Sarah Lee in Exeter Cathedral's Lady Chapel at 8.30am on 14th June. The bride, who stayed at the Royal Clarence Hotel, was given away by her sister in law. The groom's best man was his son. They honeymooned in Cumberland.

National: 17th June, Police sergeant Thomas Green was killed when Canadian troops rioted in Epsom. 15th June UK aviators John Alcock + Arthur Brown made the first non-stop transatlantic flight.

International: 21st June, at Scapa Flow, German sailors scuttled 52 of 74 interned ships. 28th June Germany was forced to sign the Versailles Treaty.

AND

REV WILLIAM DURHAM

Born 1857 in Lancashire, his father William, also a vicar, was born in Calcutta, his mother Mary Coralie Hobirk was born in Brazil. His father died when William was just 4
Ordained in 1880, he held various church positions before becoming Trusham's Rector in 1919.
In 1880 he married Priscilla Arthur; she died in 1917. They had three children: Marguerite who died in 1887 aged 6, Arthur, killed by mine explosion in 1917, William who died in India, a few months after being his father's best man. Family sadness continued. Rev Durham was killed in a climbing accident on Whit Monday 18th May 1921, on Tryfan, Snowdonia, leaving a young widow and a 1 year old daughter.
